Family Support Worker will provide guidance and support to Mr. [redacted] in maintaining contact with child's providers, ensuring follow through with appointments/recommendations, and strengthening parents advocacy skills. Family Support Worker will address parent/child roles, and age-appropriate expectations and guidelines around personal space and boundaries, family activities, parent/child interactions, appropriate topics for conversation, and communication. Family Support Worker will provide information, guidance, and support to parents in understanding age-appropriate supervision, selecting safe, appropriate caregivers, and developing safety guidelines for supervision specific to the family's needs.
